#### **SPEAKERS**



Josh Buice, President of G3 Ministries, serves as the pastor of Pray's Mill Baptist Church in Douglasville, Georgia. He is also Assistant Professor of Preaching at Grace Bible Theological Seminary in Conway, Arkansas. Josh is the husband of Kari and father of four children: Karis, John Mark, Kalli, and Judson. He studied at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, where he earned his MDiv and DMin in expository preaching. Josh has a passion for biblical preaching, missions, church planting, and the local church. In his spare time, he enjoys reading, traveling with his family, and the outdoors. He maintains a blog at G3Min.org called "Delivered by Grace."

**Joel Beeke** served as president of Puritan Reformed Theological Seminary from its founding in 1995 until 2023. He presently serves as the seminary's chancellor and professor of systematic theology and homiletics. He is a pastor of the Heritage Reformed Congregation in Grand Rapids, Michigan (since 1986), editor of the Puritan Reformed Journal and the Banner of Sovereign Grace Truth, board chairman of Reformation Heritage Books, president of Inheritance Publishers, and vice-president of the Dutch Reformed Translation Society.





Steven J. Lawson is the founder and president of OnePassion Ministries, a ministry that equips and energizes a new generation of Bible expositors. Dr. Lawson's ministry focuses on the exposition of God's Word verse-by-verse and the instruction of other men to do the same. He is the author of many books, such as The Moment of Truth, The Cost: What It Takes to Follow Jesus, Foundations of Grace, Pillars of Grace, The Unwavering Determination of Jonathan Edwards, and The Expository Genius of John Calvin, among others. Dr. Lawson is a Teaching Fellow with Ligonier Ministries, a Professor of Preaching, and the Dean of the Doctor of Ministry program at The Master's Seminary, as well as the Executive Editor of Expositor Magazine. In addition, he serves on the boards of directors for The Master's University and Seminary, Ligonier Ministries, and Reformation Bible College. Dr. Lawson attended Texas Tech University (BBA), Dallas Theological Seminary (ThM), and Reformed Theological Seminary (DMin), served as a pastor for thirty-four years in Arkansas and Alabama, and is currently the lead preacher at Trinity Bible Church of Dallas. His wife, Anne, and he have three sons and one daughter.

**Tom Pennington** has served as Pastor-Teacher at Countryside Bible Church since October, 2003. Tom completed his B.A. and M.A. at Bob Jones University and served as a member of the faculty while taking additional Ph.D. classes in New Testament Interpretation. In 2013, he received an honorary Doctor of Divinity (D.D.) from The Master's University. Tom's teaching ministry is featured on The Word Unleashed. In addition to his role as Pastor-Teacher, he is actively involved internationally in training pastors in expository preaching and also serves as the Dean of The Master's Seminary-Dallas distance location.
